- There are 51 countries in Europe with a total of more than 742 million people living on the continent.
- Moscow in Russia is the largest city with more than 12 million inhabitants.
- The Smallest country is Vatican City, in the centre of Rome.
- Volga River in Russia (3,692metres/2,295miles) is Europe's longest river.
- The Danube is the most important commercial waterway in Europe.
- Major natural attractions in Europe include: The Alps, Norwegian Fjords, The Costa del Sol and Lake Como.
- Major man made attractions in Europe include: The Eifel Tower, The Colosseum, Buckingham Palace and The Acropolis.
- The European Union (EU) is a collection of 27 countries
- The EU exists to promote trade and political links between these countries
- Over 700 million tourists visit Europe each year.
