

- ☐ About 50 percent of the plants and animals on the earth live in the rainforest. ☐ Rainforests are found on all of the different continents,
- except for Antarctica because it is far too cold there. ☐ There are two different types of rainforest: temperate
- and tropical.
- ☐ A fifth of our fresh water is found in tropical rainforests, the Amazon Basin to be exact.
- ☐ Within four square miles of tropical rainforest, you will find 1500 flowering plant species, 750 types of trees.
