




Year 3 Lent 1 Newsletter

English

This half term as writers, we will be writing a range of genres based around our History theme, The Ancient Egyptians.

This half term as writers, we will be focusing on: **Fiction**



We will look at this re-telling of the class story and attempt to write our own versions of the story.

Non-fiction



We will look at the discovery of Tutankhamun's tomb. We will write a newspaper recount of these events. We will also begin to use paragraphs in our writing.

Maths

In Maths, this half term we will be using White Rose Maths. As Mathematicians, we will be focusing on:

- Multiplication and Division
- Length and perimeter
- Fractions
- Mass and capacity


As mathematicians, we will be focusing on our mathematical vocabulary and our reasoning skills. White Rose models and supports children's learning in instilling a growth mindset approach to maths and will focus on helping all children to build a deep understanding of maths concepts. The mastery programme is designed to spark curiosity and excitement and nurture confidence in maths.

RE

Our focus for RE this half term will be **Journeys** and **Listening and Sharing**.

The Journeys topic looks at the journey in faith we make.

The Listening and Sharing topic looks at the wonders of the Eucharist.
