English

This half term as writers, we will be working on a range of genres.

We will be focusing on:

Non-fiction



We will look at the life and achievements of Mary Anning. This will allow us to focus on chronology and writing a simple timeline of her life. We will also begin to use paragraphs in our writing.

Fiction



Using this innovative and creative book we will write Character descriptions of our frogs.

We will also focus on adventure writing based on a couple pages from the book

Fiction



Looking at persuasive writing and informative writing, children will create a warning poster for frogs to help them cross the road, using key features.

Maths

In Maths, this half term we will be using White Rose Maths. As Mathematicians, we will be focusing on:

-Addition and subtraction of 2- and 3-digit numbers.

-Multiplication and Division

As mathematicians, we will be focusing on our mathematical vocabulary and our reasoning skills. White Rose models and supports children's learning in instilling a growth mindset approach to maths and will focus on helping all children to build a deep understanding of maths concepts. The mastery programme is designed to spark curiosity and excitement and nurture confidence in maths.

RE

Our focus for RE this half term will be **Prophecy and Promise**.

This topic looks at the prophecy of Jesus' birth and the promises we make to God.
