




Year 3 Lent 2 Newsletter

Welcome back, I hope you all had an enjoyable break and are ready to be back at school. Here is an overview of our learning for this next exciting half term.

English

This half term as writers, we will be writing a range of genres based around our topic theme, Volcanoes.

This half term as writers, we will be focusing on: **Fiction**



We will look at this re-telling of the class story and attempt to write our own versions of the story.

Non-fiction



We will write a non-chronological report on volcanoes. We will also continue to use paragraphs in our writing.

Maths

In Maths, this half term we will be using White Rose Maths. As Mathematicians, we will be focusing on:

- Length and perimeter
- Fractions
- Mass and capacity

As mathematicians, we will be focusing on our mathematical vocabulary and our reasoning skills. White Rose models and supports children's learning in instilling a growth mindset approach to maths and will focus on helping all children to build a deep understanding of maths concepts. The mastery programme is designed to spark curiosity and excitement and nurture confidence in maths.

RE

Our focus for RE this half term will be **Desert to Garden.** This topic follows the journey through the season of Lent up to Easter.

We will be paying particular attention to interpret questions and considering the author's choices to support our understanding of the text.
