| 4. | What happens during Confirmation? | In the Sacrament people are strengthened in faith through the power of the Holy Spirit, the gifts of the Spirit are increased. | |
| 5. | The Bishop | The Bishop usually administers confirmation. The Bishop extends his hands over the confirmands as a successor of the apostles. He says "Be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit." | |
| 6. | Spiritual change | During confirmation, the person is invited to live a life inspired by God's grace and the Holy Spirit | |
| 7. | Oil of Chrism | This is the oil of anointing. The anointing with chrism marks a Christian's total belonging to Christ. | |
