### Sacrament of Confirmation

1.	<b>Sacrament</b>	An outward sign of an inward grace through which Christians share in God's love through the Holy Spirit. They are meeting points with God.
2.	<b>Sacrament of Initiation</b>	Confirmation is one of the three sacraments of initiation of the Church. The other two are Baptism and Eucharist (First Holy Communion)
3.	<b>Confirmation</b>	This sacrament recalls the Holy Spirit descending on the disciples at Pentecost. It is when a Christian becomes a full member of the Church.
4.	<b>What happens during Confirmation?</b>	In the Sacrament people are strengthened in faith through the power of the Holy Spirit, the gifts of the Spirit are increased.
5.	<b>The Bishop</b>	The Bishop usually administers confirmation. The Bishop extends his hands over the confirmands as a successor of the apostles. He says "Be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit."
6.	<b>Spiritual change</b>	During confirmation, the person is invited to live a life inspired by God's grace and the Holy Spirit
7.	<b>Oil of Chrism</b>	This is the oil of anointing. The anointing with chrism marks a Christian's total belonging to Christ.
