




Year 3 Pentecost 1 Newsletter

English


This half term as writers, we will be writing a range of genres based around our topic theme, The Romans.

This half term as writers, we will be focusing on: **Fiction**



We will look at this famous Roman myth and create our own origin myths. We will also create haiku poems based on the Romans.

Non-fiction



We will write a non-chronological report on the Romans. We will also continue to use paragraphs in our writing.

Maths

In Maths, this term we will be using White Rose Maths. Over the final Pentecost term, we will be focusing on:

- Fractions
- Money
- Time
- Shape
- Statistics

As mathematicians, we will be focusing on our mathematical vocabulary and our reasoning skills. White Rose models and supports children's learning in instilling a growth mindset approach to maths and will focus on helping all children to build a deep understanding of maths concepts.
